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CONGRESSWOMAN VAL HOYLE TO MEET WITH MAPLETON WATER DISTRICT REGARDING CRITICAL
INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS

MAPLETON, Ore. — Congresswoman Val Hoyle will meet with representatives of the Mapleton Water District at 3 p.m. Wednesday, July 29, 2026, to discuss the District's infrastructure needs and ongoing efforts to secure federal funding for critical water-system improvements.

The meeting will begin at the Mapleton Branch of the Siuslaw Public Library, located at 88148 Riverview Avenue in Mapleton. The event is open to members of the public and the media.

The discussion will include H.R. 9171, which is currently under consideration by the U.S. House Committee on Appropriations. The bill includes a proposed allocation of \$746,868 for infrastructure upgrades benefiting the Mapleton Water District.

If the bill and funding make it through the legislative process, the District intends to use the funding to upgrade the water main serving Riverview Avenue. The mainline is a critical component of the District's water system and plays an important role in maintaining service throughout the community.

District representatives will also discuss Mapleton's broader infrastructure challenges and the importance of continued federal support for small, rural water systems. The meeting will provide an opportunity for Hoyle and staff to provide an update on the federal funding process while discussing the additional investments needed to provide safe, reliable water service to the Mapleton community.
